



Who we are

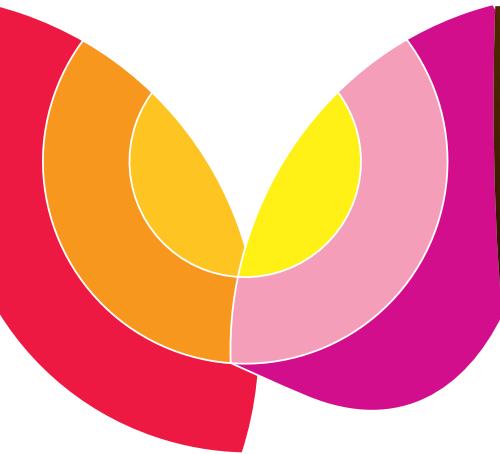
Elysium Neurological provides specialist rehabilitation and care for people living with a range of different and complex neurological conditions including acquired brain injury, spinal injury, progressive and other neurological conditions.

Stanley House and Bowley Court sit together in the heart of the beautiful Herefordshire countryside amidst orchards and landscaped grounds. The two units comprising of 41 beds in total were purpose built to provide long term neurological care for people requiring skilled and experienced care to meet their specific needs and symptoms.

People we care for

A neurological diagnosis can cover a wide range of specific conditions with an even wider range of symptoms. Stanley House and Bowley Court provide the specialist care and expert therapeutic interventions for people affected by the majority of neurological disorders including:

- Acquired Brain Injuries including those acquired through trauma or stroke, subarachnoid haemorrhage, tumour or anoxia
- Neuroprogressive Disorders e.g. Huntington's Disease, Dementia, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's Disease and Motor Neurone Disease
- Peripheral neuropathy conditions e.g. Guillain Barré Syndrome
- Bowley Court is registered to accept patients over the age of 17
- Those with Learning Disability (LD) diagnosis





Accommodation

Accommodation is split across two individual units located on the same site. Forty one individual rooms are located around communal areas all of which are tastefully decorated and homely in feel.

As most residents make Stanley House and Bowley Court their home we positively encourage personalisation of the rooms.

The views from both buildings extend across the countryside and the well-kept gardens which are accessible to all residents. There are four individual dining rooms providing choice and space for the residents when dining and multiple lounge and communal areas – many of which display the residents' own artwork.

Residents have access to a sensory room and extensive gardens, including polytunnel for residents to grow vegetables. There is also a summer house for outdoor activities, family visits and relaxation.





Facilities

Therapy Suites - These well equipped, dedicated areas provide an environment where people can engage with the therapy team to work on their individually designed programmes. The focus is on wellbeing and improved quality of life.

Minibus - Available to take the residents to appointments and on short excursions.

Grounds - Extensive grounds surrounding Stanley House and Bowley Court provide a wonderful space for residents and their families to spend time together. Ample free parking is available for visitors.

Laundry - This is provided for the residents as part of the service.

Food and diets - All dietary needs can be met by our in-house catering team in collaboration with dietitians - this includes modified diets and specific requirements.

Free Wi-Fi - This is provided across the majority of communal areas and bedrooms.

These superb facilities ensure that Stanley House and Bowley Court can support:

- Residents who have long term and neuroprogressive disorders
- Residents needing nursing and physical care including management of PEG feeding regimes, catheter and bowel care
- Residents with complex physical and health needs as a result of a progressive condition or neurological event
- Residents who are in a prolonged disorder of consciousness and those requiring end of life care

Pathways

The spectrum of Elysium Neurological services across the UK covers the following five pathways for inpatient, residential care and respite stays for men and women over the age of 18.



Neurorehabilitation

Assessment, rehabilitation, flexible packages for ABI or neurological conditions



Complex Physical Conditions – as a result of a neurological problem

Including disorders of consciousness, spinal injury, tracheostomy care, ventilation and complex stroke



Neurobehavioural

Specialised behavioural programmes including people who may be detained under the Mental Act 1983 (amended 2007)



Neuroprogressive Conditions

Including Huntington's Disease, Motor Neurone Disease, Multiple Sclerosis and Parkinson's Disease



Complex Dementias

Including Frontotemporal, Pick's, Lewy Body, Korsakoff, young-onset or vascular

Stanley House and Bowley Court offer pathways for the following:

- **Complex Physical Conditions**
- **Neuroprogressive Conditions**
- **Complex Dementias**

We can provide a home for as long as the person needs our support, providing we can continue to meet their needs.

Expert Team

We have an expert interdisciplinary team including nursing (RGN & RMN), neuropsychiatry, speech and language therapy, physiotherapy and art therapy all working alongside local GPs who provide dedicated clinics.

Specialised Care

We are committed to providing the highest standard of care and support, encompassing the physical, psychological, emotional and social needs of all residents. We offer a range of care packages to suit the individual needs of those accessing our specialist services. These include:

- **Long term complex care including specialist nursing to provide respiratory support**
- **Sensory assessment and complex care for patients with disorders of consciousness**
- **Effective management of behaviours such as verbal or physical aggression, agitation or disinhibition**
- **Palliative care**

Stanley House and Bowley Court offer therapies and activities which include physiotherapy and art therapy. In addition to input from a Consultant Psychiatrist, there are also bi-weekly GP visits. Stanley House and Bowley Court provide a dedicated and skilled approach to the care offered to residents maximising their quality of life and facilitating meaningful activities each day.

Outcomes

Those residents accessing our longer term complex care pathways are monitored through a variety of clinical assessment tools. All assessments and outcome measures are chosen from current, evidence-based and industry recognised tools.

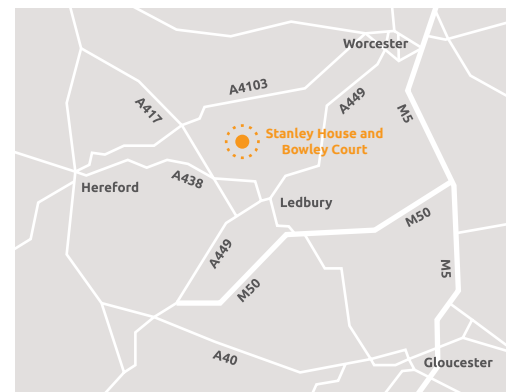

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Referrals/Admission process

Referrals can be made by clinicians, commissioners, case managers or directly from family carers. We ask that as much information as possible is made available regarding the potential resident and their neurological condition. Our clinical team will review the information received quickly and efficiently and if appropriate, will arrange for a face to face assessment to enable the team to accurately evaluate the specific and individual needs each person requires.
