Overview

1a Upper Brighton Road provides a specialist residential service for men who have a learning disability, or who are autistic, and have behaviours which, due to their diagnosis may be of concern/distress. Residents may also have profound and multiple communication difficulties, sensory impairments and physical health problems.

As well as supporting individuals who have a learning disability, who are autistic, we are specialists in working with additional complex needs including:

- Epilepsy
- ADHD
- Cerebral palsy
- Self-injurious behaviours
- Individuals with mobility issues who may require a wheelchair can also be considered for the service

The service is staffed 24 hours a day by a dedicated team of Support Workers, led by an experienced Registered Manager.

The service is designed for those individuals who require a high level of support to live within a community setting and will continue to require this longer term. Clients may be transitioning from children's residential services, education, or moving out of the family home.

We are also experienced in successfully managing clients moving from services where their placements may have broken down or where their needs are no longer being met.

The aim of the service is to encourage individuals to lead a full and purposeful life, enabling them to live more independently in the heart of the community. This is achieved through a programme of active community engagement, that promotes meaningful social networks and the development of bespoke coping strategies. This also supports developing further independence and social skills, including participating in meal preparation, learning about safety measures both in their environment and out in the community.

All residents are registered with the local GP which allows access to specialist Clinicians.

We are proud of the excellent relationships with the families/carers and friends of the individuals we support, who are encouraged to play an active part in the lives of their loved ones.

1a Upper Brighton Road is situated in Surbiton, Surrey and provides nine en-suite bedrooms, two lounges and a large garden. There are an excellent range of community facilities and amenities close by.

Surbiton is a suburban area located in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames in southwest London. It is known for its leafy streets, green spaces, and excellent transport links. The town is served by Surbiton railway
